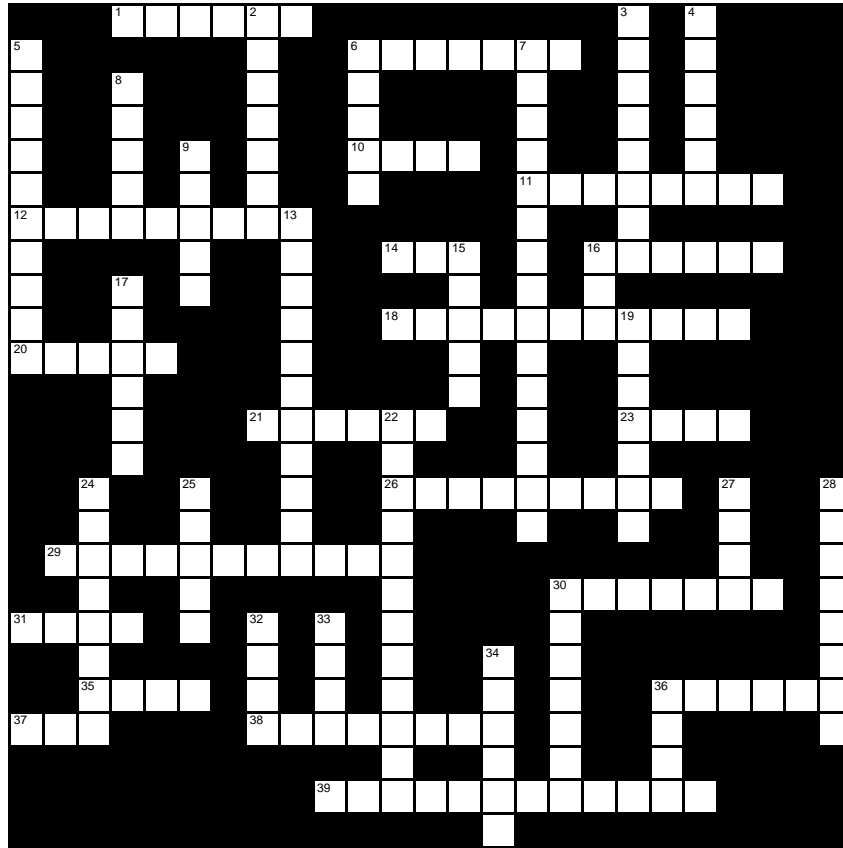


# Lean Crossword Puzzle

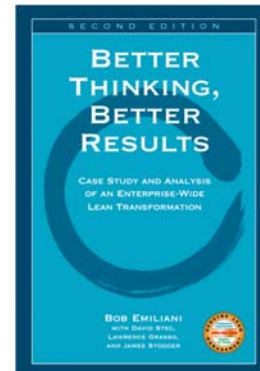
